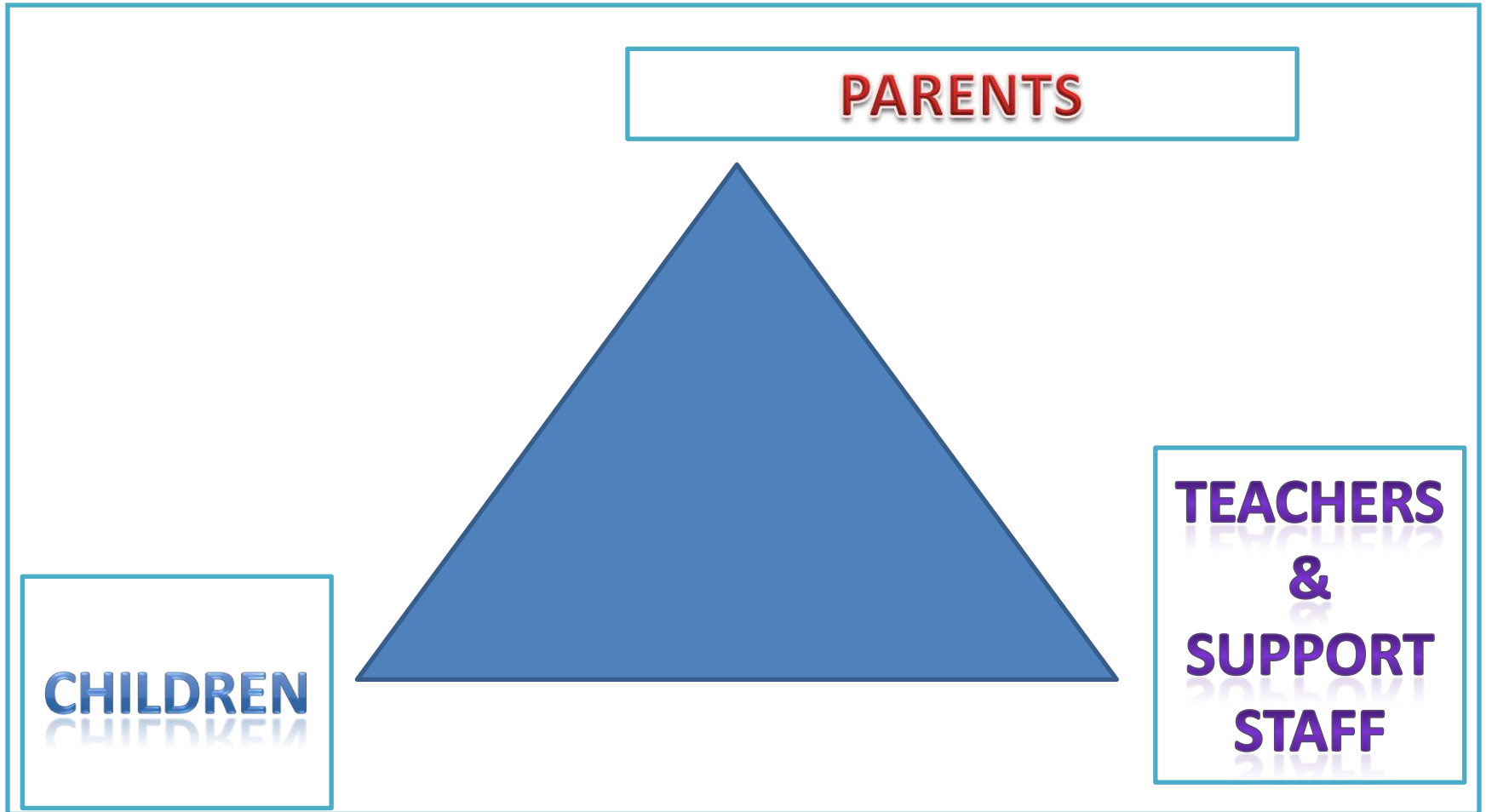

The Learning Triangle

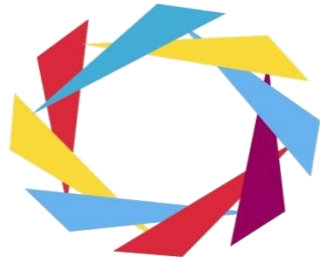




Aim and Vision- Wallscourt Farm Academy

Achieving High Standards - Positive Experience for All

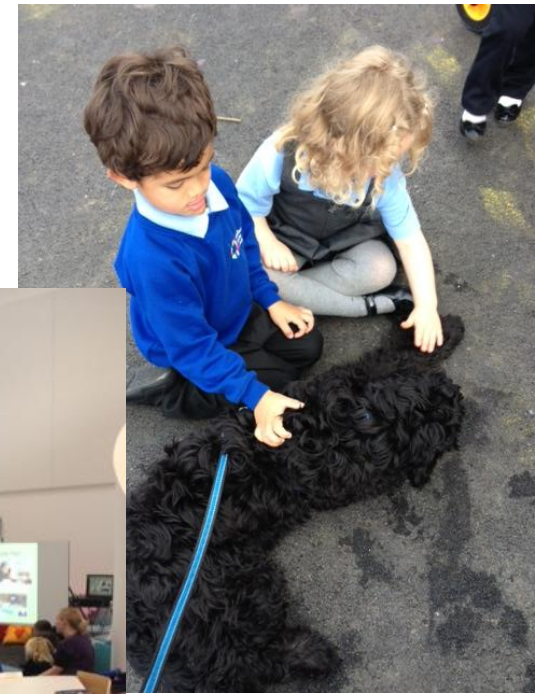
- We will establish a teaching centre in the academy with easy access to and from UWE staff, students, resources and facilities
